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Hello, I am a candidate considering paying for Uber transportation for Kentucky residents who need to obtain, renew, replace, or update identification so they can meet voting identification requirements.

Transportation would be available without regard to political affiliation, candidate preference, or whom the resident supports. The recipient would not be required to vote, support me, discuss voting choices, receive campaign materials, or participate in campaign activity.

I respectfully request an advisory opinion addressing the following questions:

1. Would my personal payment for this transportation constitute a campaign contribution, campaign expenditure, or other reportable transaction?
2. If the payment is reportable, would the electronic Uber transaction and itemized receipt satisfy Kentucky's payment, documentation, and reporting requirements?
3. How should the payee be identified on a campaign-finance report: Uber, the individual driver, or another party?
4. Does the check-payment requirement in KRS 119.205(5) apply when transportation is provided to obtain or update identification rather than to transport a voter to the polls on Election Day?
5. Would the answer change if the transportation were paid from my campaign account instead of my personal funds?

I would appreciate guidance on the proper payment method, recordkeeping, and reporting procedure before offering this assistance.
