In re: Campaign Fund of Charles Lovett for Kentucky Secretary of State, Charles Lovett, Candidate/Treasurer

SUPPLEMENTAL STAFF REPORT, RECOMMENDATIONS AND ORDER

This case came before the Kentucky Registry of Election Finance (Registry) at its September 24, 2015 regular meeting, pursuant to Notice and Staff Report (Staff Report) dated August 12, 2015. Charles Lovett (Respondent or Lovett), Candidate for Kentucky Secretary of State, and Treasurer of the Campaign Fund of Charles Lovett for Kentucky Secretary of State (Lovett Campaign Fund) responded to the Staff Report, by letter received by the Registry on September 22, 2015. At the Registry's September 24, 2015 meeting, the Registry was presented the Supplemental Staff Report and Recommendations as set forth herein. The Registry did not request any Respondent to appear at its meeting to present additional information relative to the case, and Lovett did not appear at the meeting. The proceeding was transcribed and is authorized by KRS 121.120, KRS 121.140, and 32 KAR 2:040.

SUPPLEMENTAL STAFF REPORT

Introduction

Charles Lovett (Lovett) was a candidate for the office of Kentucky Secretary of State during the 2015 Democratic primary. Lovett notified the Registry of his candidacy on January 26, 2015, naming himself as Treasurer of the Campaign Fund of Charles Lovett for Kentucky Secretary of State (Lovett Campaign Fund). The campaign's sole Election Finance Statement, received by the Registry on June 25, 2015, reflects that the Lovett Campaign Fund terminated its primary election campaign activities on June 22, 2015, after spending \$389.99 in the primary election reporting period.

Pursuant to KRS 121.120(4)(k), Registry Auditor David Simpson audited the Lovett Campaign Fund's 2015 primary election account. The audit revealed that the Lovett Campaign Fund may have violated KRS 121.120(6)(h), by failing to electronically file election finance statements required to be submitted to the Registry. The audit also noted that Lovett failed to designate a campaign account for receipt of all contributions and disbursement of campaign expenditures, in apparent violation of KRS 121.220(1) and (2). The audit report formed the basis of the General Counsel's reason to believe findings in the Staff Report dated August 12, 2015. However, Staff Report was returned "unclaimed" to the Registry on September 8, 2015. Lovett was re-notified by telephone call and Staff Report mailed first class on September 14, 2015.

The Registry received Lovett's response on September 22, 2015. In response to the Staff Report, Lovett stated he did not recall having received the February 2, 2015 letter from the Registry Auditor, which included information to assist in compliance with Kentucky's campaign finance laws and regulations. Lovett also stated that he was scheduled for candidate training on at least three (3) separate occasions; however, the training was postponed due to conflicts with his work schedule and a snow storm. Lovett claimed that, because the information was not effectively delivered to him, he should not be held liable for the violations.³

A review of the Registry's record confirmed Lovett's response. The original February 2, 2015 letter was located by Registry staff on September 22, 2015 in an envelope addressed to Lovett together with informational materials that the Registry's auditor intended to hand-deliver to Lovett at a meeting initially scheduled on Thursday, February 5, 2015, which never occurred.

The February 5, 2015 meeting was rescheduled for February 9, 2015, which was also cancelled and rescheduled for an undetermined date, which apparently also never occurred due to weather concerns.

ANALYSIS

I. Alleged failure to Electronically Report Campaign Finances

The audit report notes that the Lovett Campaign Fund failed to electronically report its campaign finances despite notification of the requirement by the Registry's auditors. KRS 121.120(6)(h) requires "candidates . . . for statewide office, beginning with elections scheduled in 2015, to electronically report all election finance reports that must be submitted to the registry under this chapter." See KRS 121.120(6)(h). The audit report states that the Lovett Campaign Fund was notified of the electronic filing requirement by letter from the Registry's auditor dated February 2, 2015, and by courtesy call prior to the due date for filing the 30 Day Post Election Finance Statement.⁴

While the record establishes that Lovett did not receive the letter from the Registry dated February 2, 2015, this does not excuse him from complying with all campaign finance requirements. As the Lovett Campaign Fund failed to electronically file election finance statements required to be submitted to the Registry pursuant to KRS 121.120(6)(h), Lovett should be held responsible for his campaign's failure to electronically report its campaign finances during the 2015 primary.

II. Alleged failure to designate primary campaign depository

Kentucky law requires a candidate to designate one (1) primary campaign depository to deposit all contributions and disburse all expenditures made in connection with the candidate's campaign. See KRS 121.220(1) and (2). The audit states that Lovett apparently used personal

funds only in connection with the campaign and provided the Registry's auditor with no evidence of a separate campaign fund.⁵ Lovett states in his response that he did not open a campaign account because he was using personal funds only and did not seek contributions for his campaign. He also claims that he was not aware of this requirement, as he was unable to attend the candidate training session.⁶

The requirement to designate a primary campaign depository applies to all Kentucky candidates. Despite the Registry's failure to deliver a statewide candidate welcome packet to Lovett, the requirement to designate a primary campaign depository is easily ascertained on review of the Registry's website (https://kref.ky.gov) relating to candidates. As a candidate for statewide office, Lovett should at a minimum have reviewed the website to ascertain the obligation to open a campaign account separate and apart from his personal account in the event someone wanted to make a contribution to his campaign.

RECOMMENDATIONS

For reasons outlined above, the General Counsel recommends that the Registry find probable cause to believe that the Lovett Campaign Fund, by and through its Candidate/ Treasurer, Charles Lovett, violated KRS 121.120(6)(h), by failing to electronically report campaign finances during the 2015 primary; and KRS 121.220(1) and (2) by failing to designate a primary campaign depository in connection with his campaign for Kentucky Secretary of State.

Therefore, it is further recommended, pursuant to 32 KAR 2:050, that the Registry refer the violations of KRS 121.120(6)(h), and KRS 121.220(1) and (2) to the Executive Director and General Counsel for conciliation.

ORDER

Having considered the above Supplemental Staff Report, Respondent having received notice, and being otherwise duly advised, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the facts, legal analysis, and recommendations of the General Counsel as set forth herein are approved and adopted as part of this Order, consistent with the Registry's action at its September 24, 2015 regular meeting.

Based on the record of the case, the Registry FINDS PROBABLE CAUSE to believe that Lovett, as Candidate and Treasurer of the Lovett Campaign Fund, violated KRS 121.160(6)(h) by failing to electronically report the campaign's finances with the Registry in the 2015 primary election campaign; and KRS 121.220(1) and (2) by failing to designate a primary campaign depository in connection with his campaign for Kentucky Secretary of State.

THE REGISTRY, THEREFORE, ORDERS and hereby REFERS the abovereferenced violations by Lovett to the Executive Director and General Counsel to begin conciliation proceedings.



CAMPAIGN FUND OF CHARLES LOVETT FOR SECRETARY OF STATE 2015 PRIMARY ELECTION AUDIT REPORT FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 26, 2015 (INCEPTION) THROUGH JUNE 22, 2015 (TERMINATION)

INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to the provisions of the Campaign Finance Regulation, Kentucky Revised Statutes, Chapter 121, Charles Lovett notified the Kentucky Registry of Election Finance of his intent to seek nomination as a candidate for the office of Secretary of State.

The Appointment of Campaign Treasurer form designates Charles Lovett as his own treasurer.

SCOPE

The examination of the campaign's records was conducted to ascertain compliance with the Campaign Finance Regulation, Kentucky Revised Statutes, Chapter 121. We have included such comments and recommendations regarding internal control over financial transactions as we deemed necessary.

Our tests included but were not limited to the following:

- Reconciliation of the campaign's bank account.
- Review of receipts and disbursements documentation.
- Review of in-kind contributions and fund raising activities.
- Comparison of the campaign's records to the campaign's reports, as filed.

SUMMARY OF RESULTS

CRITERIA

1. CRITERIA: KRS 121.120(6)(h):

Require candidates and slates of candidates running for statewide office, and campaign committees of candidates and slates of candidates registered to run for statewide office, beginning with elections scheduled in 2015, to electronically report all election finance reports that must be submitted to the registry under this chapter.

FINDINGS

The campaign was notified of the electronic filing requirement by auditor letter dated February 2, 2015 (Exhibit 1). The candidate was scheduled several times for a candidate training session, during which this requirement would have been discussed, but due to various reasons, the candidate was unable to attend and cancelled. The candidate selected the \$3000 or less reporting option. Auditor Greg Cordier made a courtesy call to the candidate before the due date of the 30 day post primary report to discuss the electronic reporting requirement, however, the candidate failed to electronically file the 30 day post election finance statement terminating the campaign (Exhibit 2).

CRITERIA

2. CRITERIA: KRS 121.220(1) and (2):

(1) Each candidate, slate of candidates, and each committee shall, before receiving any contributions or expending any money, designate one (1) primary campaign depository for the purpose of depositing all contributions received and disbursing all expenditures made by the candidate, slate of candidates, or committee.

and

(2) All funds received by the campaign treasurer or any deputy campaign treasurer of any candidate, slate of candidates, or committee shall be deposited in a campaign depository in an account designated "Campaign Fund of (name of candidate or committee)."

FINDINGS

The requirement to maintain a primary campaign depository designated "Campaign Fund of" is outlined in the material accompanying the audit letter sent to the candidate dated February 2, 2015 (See Exhibit 1). This requirement also would have been discussed with the candidate had an initial auditor meeting been scheduled. Upon review of the filed Election Finance Statement and submitted invoices, the candidate apparently used his own personal funds for website design/fees and photography (Exhibit 2). No evidence of a separate "campaign fund" was provided by the candidate.






